
Correct sequence of the given hills from the north to the south is Pir Panjal Range, Naga Hills, Kaimur Hills, Gawilgarh Hills.

Pir Panjal Range (Jammu and Kashmir) extends from the Jhelum River to the upper Beas River and is separated from the Zaskar Range by the Valley of Kashmir.

Naga Hills (Indo-Myanmar border) lies south of Patkai Bum and north of Manipur Hills. Its highest peak is Saramati (3,826m).

Kaimur Hills are eastward continuation of **Vindhyan Range**, extending from Jabalpur district of Madhya Pradesh to around Sasaram in Bihar.

Gawilgarh Hills (Southern MP and Maharashtra) lies in the eastern part of the **Satpura Range**. The Purna river, a tributary of the Tapi rises from the Gawilgarh Hills in the Betul district of Madhya Pradesh.
