



By November 1857 Haryana was again under the control of British leader of revolting regions were punished and many hanged except Rao Tula Ram who escaped.
(Martyrdom Day 23rd September in the memory of Rao Tularam)

Congress and National movement in Haryana

First session of Congress 1885:-

Lala Muralidhar of Ambala (Grand oldman of Punjab) represented Haryana.

Second session: - 2 representatives of Haryana

- Deen Dayal Sharma (Jhajjar)
- Babu Balmukund Gupt (Rohtak)

3rd session: -

Represented by Lala Lajpat Rai (Hisar)

- Morley Minto Reforms increasing the involvement of Indian in government. So Jawahar Lal Bhargava and Chaudhary Lal Chand were made members of Punjab legislative council.
- Bal Mukund Gupt criticised reforms through **articles like ShivShambhu ke chitthe.**
- Lala Muralidhar gave back this title of Rai Bahadur during Non cooperation Movement.

Protest against Simon commission

Main leader: Dr Satyapal, Pt. Nekiram Sharma, Pt. Shriram Sharma

Main centres: -Rohtak, Ambala, Jhajjar

- Branch of Punjab Naujawan Sabha formed at Rohtak

Civil Disobedience Movement (CDM)

Dandi March: -Mahatma Ganhi started on 12th March 1930 with 78 Satyagrahi -Lala **SurajBhan of Ambala** was one among them.

Chaudhary Devilal quitted School during CDM

Quit India Movement

Many protest occurred at various places.

INA had about 2845 soldiers from Haryana.

Rowlatt Act and Satyagraha

First Protest: - Ambala

Gandhiji: - arrested from **Palwal on 10th April 1919**

Non Cooperation Movement

First meeting: - Panipat

Fore front leader: - Lala Lajpat Rai

Gandhiji visited: - Bhiwani 15 Feb 1920, Kalayat 16 feb1920, Rohtak 17th feb1920.

Gandhiji's meeting in Bhiwani 22 October 1920 organised by Haryana Kesari Pt. Neki Ram Sharma

Gandhiji Ambala Visit: - March 8, 1921

HARYANA IN FIRST AND SECOND WORLD WAR

First World War Haryana was one of the recruiting centres

- Nekiram Sharma was against Recruitment.

During 2nd world war, Punjab supported England

- Direct conflict between Chotu Ram and Jinnah for changing Unionist ministry as Muslim league

1946 Election and Independence

- Congress formed government with the support of Unionist Party.
- Chaudhary Lahiri Singh was part of government.
- 1946 Gandhi visited Sohna in Support of Muhammad Yunis Khan
- 9th Dec, 1947 Gandhiji visited Panipat to appeal Muslims to be United (invited by Maulana Lakullah)
