Kartal is an ancient instrument mainly used in devotional / folk songs. It has derived its name from the Sanskrit words 'kara' meaning hand and 'tala' meaning clapping.



The khol is a terracotta two-sided drum used in northern and eastern India for accompaniment with

devotional music (bhakti).



The kanjira, khanjiri or ganjira, a South Indian frame drum, is an instrument of the tambourine family.
