 The period between the 4th century and 6th century AD is known as the Golden Age of India because of the larger achievements Indians made in the fields of mathematics, astronomy, sculpting and painting during the Gupta Empire.

Guptas contribution to art

- Numismatics: The Gupta gold coin is known as dinaras. The gold coins of the Gupta rulers are the extraordinary examples of artistic excellence. The coins depicted the ruling monarch on the obverse and carried legends with the figure of a goddess on the reverse. Gupta introduced silver coins on model of Kushanas.
- Literature: Prominent literary figures and their works during these times are Kalidasa's Ritusamhara, Meghaduta, Abhignana Shakuntalam, Vishakadatta's Devichandraguptam, Vajja's Kaumudimahotavasam, Sudraka's Mrichakatkam, Vishnusharma's PanchaTantra, Amarakosha's Amarasimha.
- Sculptures: stone and metal sculptures of various schools developed during this time.
