Solution: d)

The Blue Flag certification requires beaches to create certain infrastructure.

Central Government declares that for the purpose of Blue Flag Certification in such identified beaches, the following activities and facilities shall be permitted in the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ), including Islands, subject to maintaining a minimum distance of 10 meters from HTL (High Tide Line)

- (a) Portable toilet blocks, change rooms and shower panels;
- (b) Grey water treatment plant;
- (c) Solid waste management plant;
- (d) Solar power plant;
- (e) Purified drinking water facility;
- (f) Beach access pathways;
- (g) Landscaping lighting;
- (h) Seating benches and sit-out umbrellas;
- (i) Outdoor play / fitness equipment;
- (j) CCTV surveillance and control room;
- (k) First aid station;
- (l) Cloak room facility;
- (m) Safety watch towers and beach safety equipment;
- (n) Beach layout, environment information boards and other signages;
- (o) Fencing, preferably vegetative;
- (p) Parking facilities;
- (q) Entry gate, tourist facilitation centre; and
- (r) Other associated facilities or infrastructure, as per requirements of Blue Flag Certification.
