Explanation:

- **United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)** was set up in 1947 by **ECOSOC**.
 - It is one of five regional commissions of the United Nations.
 - UNECE's major aim is to promote pan-European economic integration.
 - It includes 56 member States in Europe, North America and Asia.
- **The United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC)** is one of the six principal organs of the United Nations, responsible for coordinating the economic and social fields of the organization, specifically in regards to the 15 specialised agencies, the eight functional commissions and the five regional commissions under its jurisdiction.
 - The Charter **established six principal organs of the United Nations**: the General Assembly, the Security Council, **the Economic and Social Council**, the Trusteeship Council, the International Court of Justice, and the Secretariat. The United Nations family, however, is much larger, encompassing 15 agencies and several programmes and bodies.
