



- In **1984** the Government of **India** declared that **12January**, the **birthday** of **Swami Vivekananda**, will be celebrated as **National Youth Day**.

HISTORIC URBAN LANDSCAPE PROJECT

- In Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior and Orchha cities have been selected by UNESCO under this Project, which was started in the year 2011, for the inclusive and well-planned development of fast-growing historical cities while preserving the culture and heritage.
- Six cities of South Asia, including Ajmer and Varanasi in India are already involved in this project.
- The cities will be jointly developed by UNESCO, Government of India and Madhya
 Pradesh by focusing on their historical and cultural improvement.

PRASHAD SCHEME

- PM Modi inaugurated various development projects in Varanasi which includes under the Project "Development of Varanasi Under PRASHAD Scheme – Phase II".
- The 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive' (PRASHAD) is a Central Sector Scheme fully financed by the Government of India launched by the Ministry of Tourism in the year 2014-15.
- Its objective is integrated development of identified pilgrimage and heritage destinations.

ADARSH SMARAK

Minister for Culture informed Rajya Sabha that **3 monuments** of **Andhra Pradesh** have been Identified as "Adarsh Smarak" for providing additional facilities.

These Three monuments of Andhra Pradesh are

- Monuments at Nagarjunakonda, District Guntur,
- o Budhhist Remains at Salihundam, District Srikakulam, and
- Veerabhadra Temple at Lepakshi.

Further, Fort at Gandikota has been included in the Adopt-a-Heritage scheme of Ministry of Tourism, which is PPP mode.
