

## characteristics of a good Psych test:

### ① Reliability:

- also called accuracy, dependability, consistency, stability, repeatability.
- refers to consistency reflected in reproducibility of scores.
- it ensures that no guessing operates.
- there is element of predictability.
- reliability indicates the extent to which test is free from internal defects of standardisation and reliability is obtained through self-correlation of the test.

### ② Validity: degree to which the test measures what it is supposed to measure. Unlike reliability, which is revealed through self-correlation, validity is obtained by correlating the scores with external independent criterion.

criterion can be defined as the best measure of the attribute that the test <sup>is</sup> designed to measure.
