- Aim → The deal aims to build and operate a <u>718-megawatt</u> combined-cycle gas-fired power plant in Bangladesh.
- Location → The plant is proposed to be located on land allotted by Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB),
  in Meghnaghat, Narayanganj District near Dhaka.
- Combined-cycle power plant →
  - o A combined-cycle power plant is a relatively **more efficient way of producing electricity**.
  - It uses both a gas and a steam turbine together to produce up to 50 % more electricity from the same fuel than a traditional simple-cycle plant.
  - o It will **reduce** the **share of environmentally harmful** and **expensive fuels** like coal and oil.

# 4. Khadi Agarbatti Atma Nirbhar Mission

## Why in News?

• Union Minister for MSME has approved a program proposed by Khadi and Village Industries Commission(KVIC) named "Khadi Agarbatti Atma Nirbhar Mission".

### **About Mission**

- Aim → It aims at <u>creating employment</u> for unemployed and migrant workers in different parts of the country while <u>increasing domestic Agarbatti production</u> substantially.
- Mode → The scheme has been designed based on the <u>Public Private Partnership</u> (PPP) <u>mode</u>.
- Features →
- Under this, KVIC will provide <u>Automatic Agarbatti making machines</u> and <u>powder mixing machines</u> to the artisans through the private Agarbatti manufacturers who will sign the agreement as business partners.
- Further, KVIC will provide a <u>25% subsidy</u> on the <u>cost of the machines</u> and will recover the remaining 75% of the cost from the artisans in installments every month.
- The <u>business partner</u> will provide the <u>raw material</u> to the artisans for <u>making Agarbatti</u> and will <u>pay them</u> wages on a job work basis.

### 5. Pokkali Rice: Kerala

### Why in News?

• Farmers in West Bengal are experimenting with the pokkali variety of rice to tide over a crisis-like situation created by severe seawater incursion into paddy fields in the Sundarbans (owing to Cyclone Amphan).

#### **About Pokkali Rice**

- The pokkali variety of rice is known for its <u>saltwater resistance</u> and <u>flourishes</u> in the rice paddies of <u>coastal</u>
  Kerala districts.
- The uniqueness of the rice has brought it the **Geographical Indication (GI) tag** and is the subject of **continuing research**.
- The organically-grown Pokkali is famed for its **peculiar taste** and **its high protein content**.
- Pokkali has medicinal properties and its <u>higher value of antioxidants</u> and <u>low carbohydrate content</u> makes it preferable to those on a <u>low sugar diet</u>.
- Other GI Tag Registered Varieties from Kerala → <u>Kaipad</u>, <u>Wayanad</u> <u>Jeerakasala</u>, <u>Wayanad</u> <u>Gandhakasala</u>, <u>Palakkadan Matta</u> and <u>Navara</u>.
