# 1. National Productivity Council

## Why in News?

• National Productivity Council (NPC) has been granted accreditation conforming to ISO 17020:2012 by National Accreditation Board for Certification Body (NABCB), Quality Council of India (QCI).

## About NPC

- Parent body → NPC is an <u>autonomous body</u> under Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT), <u>Ministry of Commerce & Industry</u>, Government of India.
- Objective → NPC is a national level organization to **promote productivity culture** in India.
- Established in  $\rightarrow$  <u>1958</u>.
- Status → It is an <u>autonomous</u>, <u>multipartite</u>, <u>non-profit organization</u> and has been <u>registered as a</u> <u>Society</u> under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860.
- NPC is a **constituent of the Tokyo-based Asian Productivity Organisation** (APO), an Inter-Governmental Body, of which the Government of India is a founder member.
- Functions → NPC teams up with its clients to work out <u>solutions towards accelerating productivity</u>, <u>enhancing competitiveness</u>, <u>increasing profits</u>, augmenting safety and reliability and ensuring better quality. It provides <u>reliable database for decision-making</u>, improved systems and procedures, work culture as well as customer satisfaction both internal & external.

# 2. Pilot Scheme on Fortification of Rice

#### Why in News?

• Union Minister for Food & Consumer Affairs has said that Fifteen States have been identified for implementing Pilot Scheme on Fortification of Rice & its distribution through Public Distribution System(PDS).

#### About

- Type → It is a <u>Centrally Sponsored Scheme</u> which aims to <u>address anaemia and micronutrients'</u> <u>deficiency</u> amongst beneficiaries consuming rice supplied under PDS.
- Duration of Scheme: The Scheme has been approved for a **period of three years** beginning 2019-2020.
- Implementation → <u>15 State Governments</u> have <u>identified</u> their respective districts (1 district per state) for implementing the Scheme.
- <u>Already 5 states</u> of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and Chhattisgarh have <u>started the</u> <u>distribution of fortified rice</u> in their respective identified districts.

- Food Fortification → It is the <u>deliberate addition of one or more micronutrients to food</u> so as to correct or prevent a deficiency and provide a health benefit.
- Biofortification → It is the process by which the <u>nutritional quality of food crops is improved</u> through agronomic practices, conventional plant breeding or modern biotechnology.
