Gross Fixed Capital Formation

- The Gross Fixed Capital Formation is measured by the total value of a producer's acquisition less disposal of fixed assets during the accounting period plus certain additions to the value of non-produced assets realized by the productive activity of institutional units.
- The total assets at the end of the year 2020-21 have been estimated at Rs 2,76,473 crore at the current prices which is 27.28 % of the Gross State Domestic Product (10,13,323 crore).
- In the year 2020-21, there was a decline of 2.45% in the gross fixed capital formation as compared to the previous year 2019-20.
- The average contribution of private and public sector in the gross fixed capital formation in the year 2020-21 has been 76.10 and 23.90 % respectively.

Price Statistics in Rajasthan

- Regular collection of wholesale and retail prices of commodities is being done from the selected centers of the state since 1957.

Wholesale Price Index (W.P.I) of Rajasthan

(Base year 1999-2000)

- The Wholesale Price Index is only a general index that indicates the change in the price of commodities in all types of trade and transactions.
- It is also helpful in observing the relative changes in the prices of various commodity groups such as primary commodities, agricultural commodities, raw materials, industrial products, food and non-edible commodities.
- Wholesale Price Index is released on a monthly basis by the Government of Rajasthan.
- 154 items have been included in this, out of which 75 are included in primary goods group, 69 in manufactured product group and 10 in fuel, power, lighting and lubricants group.
- The primary goods group has been given a weightage of 33.894, the manufactured product group 49.853 and the fuel, power, lighting and lubricants category 16.253.
- The General Wholesale Price Index of Rajasthan has increased from 330.86 in the year 2020 to 363.23 in the year 2021, showing an increase of 9.78 %.
