The period between AD 750 and AD 1200 is referred to as the early medieval period of Indian history. It was earlier treated by historians as a 'dark phase'. It was so because during this time the whole country was divided into numerous regional states which were busy fighting with each other. But recent studies have indicated that, though politically divided, India witnessed a growth of new and rich cultural activities in the fields of art, literature and language. In fact, some of the best specimens of temple architecture and Indian literature belong to this period. Thus, far from being 'dark' it may be treated as a bright and vibrant phase of Indian history.
