

* Provision (A-370):-

1.) Kashmir is an integral part of India, it is a state listed in 1st schedule.
(Indicate :- that state has no right to secede from the union.)

(Why :- As per Art-1, India is indestructible union)

2.) Other provisions :- 3 Broad Areas -

- a.) Applicatⁿ of the laws made by parliament.
- b.) " " Other provisions of constitution.
- c.) Manner to abrogate.

a.) like all other states - the state of J&K also has all powers w respect to the matters given in the state list.

b.) w respect to union parliament's power to make laws - there are - 2 procedures -

i.) concurrence by state gov. :- On those matters of the union list & concurrent list & are not related to the subjects in Instrument of Accession (IOA).

ii.) Consultation w the gov. of the state :- those matters of union list & state list & are concurrent list & are related to the subjects in IOA - (It was signed on 26th Oct, 1947.)

b.) WRT to the applicatⁿ of Rest of the constitutⁿ - other provisions of constitutⁿ can be extended in the similar manner - i.e - either by concurrence or by consultatⁿ. In this case, president has to bring out an order meant for applicatⁿ in the state.

c.) Abrogatⁿ of A-370 :- can be abrogated only on the recommendatⁿ of the constituent Assembly, in this case also president is to bring a notification.

* Controversies w Art-370:-

1.) since its inception - there has been opposition primarily by Hindu rightist gps. - it was opposed by ^{Spiral} shayamapada mukherji.
