- In Yamuna Nagar various types of soils are found. Red chestnut soil is also found in this area. In the sub hilly region of the Shivaliks, domut, grey and sandy soils are found. The soil in some parts does not have nitrogen and phosphorous in abundance. The terrain has ample quantities of small pebbles and stones.
- In Rohtak district, the soil is fertile.
- In most areas of Jhajjar Tehsil, one can find Sand dunes. The soil here is of light Grey colour; it lacks nitrogen.
- The soil of sonapat district is sandy and domut.
- In sirsa district, red soil is found.
- In Hisar, Bhiwani and Fatehabad sandy domut soil is in abundance.
- The soil of Ambala and Kaithal district is yellowish – grey in colour. But in some parts, rocky terrain is also found.
- The soil of kurukshetra, panipat , karnal and Faridabad is yellowish- grey and fertile.
- The soil of district Mahendragarh and rewari is predominantly sandy; it is not very much fertile. The colour of this soil is light grey.
