



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Of the six principal organs of the United Nations, it is the only one not located in New York. It is composed of 15 judges elected to nine-year terms of office. The judgment is final, binding on the parties to a case and without appeal.
International Criminal Police Organization (INTERPOL)	<p>Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) special director Praveen Sinha was elected the delegate for Asia in the executive committee of INTERPOL.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> INTERPOL is an intergovernmental organization that helps coordinate the police force of 195 member countries. It is headquartered in Lyon, France. Each of the member countries hosts an INTERPOL National Central Bureau (NCB). CBI is designated as the NCB of India. 
OPEC and OPEC+	<p>Recent talks between United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC+) Plus group on extending global pact to cut oil production beyond April 2022 could not reach a consensus.</p> <p>In the backdrop of falling oil prices in 2020 due to COVID 19 pandemic, OPEC+ group in April 2020, entered into a two-year Output Pact (New Production Agreement) for steep cuts in crude production for better price discovery.</p> <p>About OPEC and OPEC+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> OPEC (HQ- Vienna) is a permanent, intergovernmental Organization, created at the Baghdad Conference, 1960. Objectives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To coordinate and unify petroleum policies among member countries. To secure fair and stable prices for petroleum producers. To ensure an efficient, economic and regular supply of petroleum to consuming nations and a fair return on capital to those investing in the industry. The 10 non-OPEC countries which export crude oil are termed as OPEC Plus(+) countries. These include Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Brunei, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mexico, Oman, Russia, South Sudan and Sudan. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It came into existence to counteract other nations' capacity to produce oil, which could limit OPEC's ability to control supply and price. 
Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Former RBI governor Urjit Patel was appointed vice-president of the AIIB. AIIB is a multilateral development bank with a mission to improve social and economic outcomes in Asia. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It was established in 2015 and is headquartered in Beijing India is a founding member and second largest shareholder in AIIB with 7.6% voting shares while China holds 26.5 % voting shares being the largest. <p>AIIB has approved more loans for India (28 projects amounting to \$6.7 billion) than any other member.</p>
Reporters Without Borders (RSF)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Based in Paris, it is one of the world's leading NGOs in the defense and promotion of freedom of information. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It has consultative status with United Nations, UNESCO and Council of Europe. It publishes annually the World Press Freedom Index.
